Sr. tose, as we all know her, spent her early lementary years at St. Malachy School in brooklyn. After her family made the move cross the borough border into Queens, he attended Sts. Joachim & Ann School n Queens Village from grades 4-8. She ttended Sacred Heart Academy for her igh school studies and subsequently St. ohn's University. She received her B.S. n Education from Brentwood College, a Master's degree from SUNY New Paltz nd her Professional Certificate in Administration from Manhattan College. n 1960, Sr. Rose made a life altering lecision to dedicate her life to Jesus by ntering the Sisters of St. Joseph Conent. She professed her final vows on August 30th, 1966.

rom 1965 through 1979, Sr. Rose aught at various schools in Queens and ong Island. Initially she was at Most rectious Blood in Long Island City, then noving to St. Benedict Joseph Labre in Richmond Hill. After two years, she was ransferred to St. Bernard in Levittown and then transferred back to St. Benedict Joseph in 1970. Nine years later, she began her Administrative career in Our Lady of Mt. Carmel in Brooklyn.

Sr. Rose eventually landed at St. Stanislaus Kostka in Queens, and as they say, "the rest is history"! 33 years of outstanding service were spent at St. Stan's, helping grow our school both spiritually and financially while continuing to provide a stellar Catholic education.
