Sister Rose Torma (formerly Sister Mary Teresita) was born in Brooklyn, NY to Raymond and Isabelle Torma. Sr. Rose, as we all know her, spent her elementary years at St. Malachy School in Brooklyn. After her family made the move across the borough border into Queens, she attended Sts. Joachim & Ann School in Queens Village from grades 4-8. She attended Sacred Heart Academy for her high school studies and subsequently St. John's University. She received her B.S. in Education from Brentwood College, a Master's degree from SUNY New Paltz and her Professional Certificate in Administration from Manhattan College. In 1960, Sr. Rose made a life altering decision to dedicate her life to Jesus by entering the Sisters of St. Joseph Convent. She professed her final vows on August 30th, 1966.

From 1965 through 1979, Sr. Rose taught at various schools in Queens and Long Island. Initially she was at Most Precious Blood in Long Island City, then moving to St. Benedict Joseph Labre in Richmond Hill. After two years, she was transferred to St. Bernard in Levittown

and then transferred back to St. Benedict Joseph in 1970. Nine years later, she began her Administrative career in Our Lady of Mt. Carmel in Brooklyn.

Sr. Rose eventually landed at St. Stanislaus Kostka in Queens, and as they say, "the rest is history"! 33 years of outstanding service were spent at St. Stan's, helping grow our school both spiritually and financially while continuing to provide a stellar Catholic education. Sr. Rose laid the groundwork for St. Stan's future, fostering relationships with teachers, students, families and the community for many, many years.

Sister Rose Torma, CSJ retired from St. Stanislaus Kostka in 2015. 33 years of hard work, dedication, and service. The generations of families that were guided under Sr. Rose are countless. She touched so many lives and did it with grace and a deep understanding of each family's needs.
