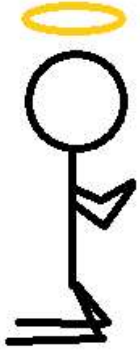
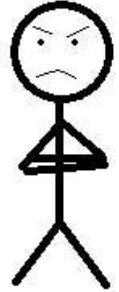


Examination of Conscience
