

THE SIXTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME



This Wednesday, February 14, is **Ash** Wednesday. (Ash Wednesday and Valentine's Day both fall on February 14th this year... despite the overlap of the days, **Ash Wednesday remains a day of fasting and abstinence from meat.** See our schedule on page 2 for the distribution of Ashes in our Parish and page 5 for a schedule of Parish events during Lent.

The Church's regulations for Fast and Abstinence during Lent are:

ABSTINENCE: All the faithful who have reached 14 years of age are required to abstain from eating meat on Ash Wednesday (February 14) and on all the Fridays of the Lenten Season.

FASTING: All the faithful between the ages of 18 and 59 (inclusive) are bound to fast on Ash Wednesday and on Good Friday (March 29) by limiting oneself to one full meal and avoiding food between meals. Light sustenance may be taken on two other occasions during the day.

Este miércoles 14 de febrero es **Miércoles de** Ceniza. (El Miércoles de Ceniza y el Día de San Valentín caen el 14 de febrero de este año... a pesar de la superposición de días, el **Miércoles de** Ceniza sigue siendo un día de ayuno y abstinencia de carne. Consulte nuestro calendario en la página 2 para la distribución de Cenizas en nuestra Parroquia y en la página 5 para un calendario de eventos parroquiales durante la Cuaresma.

Las regulaciones de la Iglesia para el Ayuno y la Abstinencia durante la Cuaresma son:

ABSTINENCIA: Todos los fieles que hayan cumplido 14 años de edad están obligados a abstenerse de comer carne el Miércoles de Ceniza (14 de febrero) y todos los viernes de la Cuaresma.

AYUNO: Todos los fieles entre 18 y 59 años (inclusive) están obligados a ayunar el Miércoles de Ceniza y el Viernes Santo (29 de marzo) limitándose a una comida completa y evitando comer entre horas. Se pueden tomar alimentos ligeros en otras dos ocasiones durante el día.
