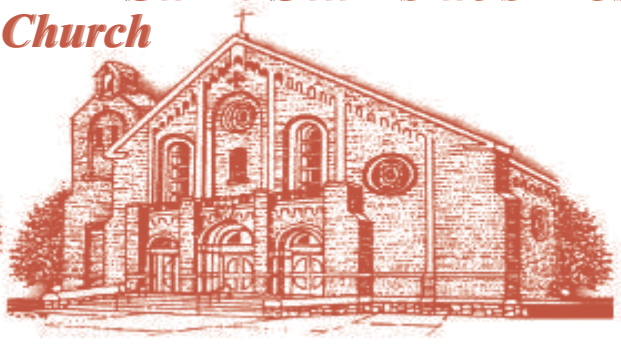

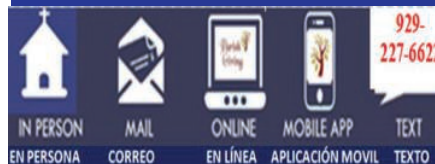

This year Ash Wednesday, the beginning of Lent, is March 5th and Easter is Sunday, April 20th. We will have a Wednesday Night Lenten Scripture Series, which will consist of a presentation and the praying of the Way of the Cross, beginning March 12th and concluding Wednesday of Holy Week with the Soup and Scripture evening prepared by the Holy Name Society. Reconciliation Monday is again Monday of Holy Week (April 14). As always, we will have the Way of the Cross sponsored by various parish groups. Please, join us for as much as you can. More information will be provided in the coming weeks.

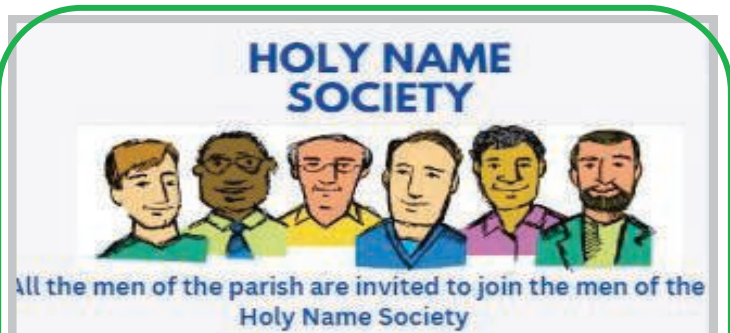

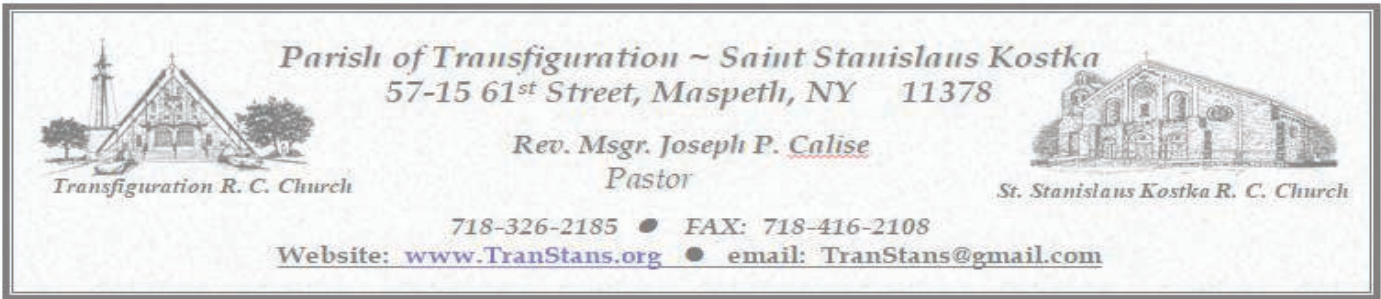

Dear Parishioners,

In September 2019, our parish was officially merged as one parish with two worship sites. One of the biggest challenges has been the administration of seven aging buildings. That is why I am writing to you today.

In August, the Diocesan Office of Buildings and Grounds did an evaluation of the properties at Transfiguration. We have been having problems with the roof for a long time. Over the years, many patchwork jobs were done but their effectiveness has worn out. Other maintenance issues were discovered. The bottom line is that the cost to make Transfiguration Church safe and stable is estimated at \$800,000. This would not include new heating and air conditioning systems. In addition, the rectory would need an estimated \$500,000 in repairs to be eligible for renting.

There are currently three churches in a very short walking distance (Transfiguration, St. Stanislaus and Holy Cross). The Catholic population no longer fills them as it once did. So, we have a problem. The lack of need for three worship sites makes it difficult to justify the cost of the repairs to Transfiguration; a cost we could not cover as a parish but would have to incur as another diocesan debt.

I presented this situation to the Parish Financial Advisory Board (Kevin Cavanagh, Dennis Gander, Mike LoCascio and Bill Valley). Although no one was in favor of the closing of Transfiguration, no one had any alternatives to recommend. The same information was presented at a joint meeting of the Financial Board and the Parish Council (in attendance were the members of the Finance Board and Maria Flaim, Sandra Martinez, Marge Migliaccio and Nick Sacco. Karin Gully attended as secretary) and the same conclusion was reached. Although it saddened everyone, I was advised to inform the Vicar General of the Diocese, Msgr. Joseph Grimaldi, that we see no option to the closing of Transfiguration Church and the sale of the property.

He will present those findings to Bishop Brennan for a decision. Nothing is definite yet but it is very probable that the Bishop will agree that there are no prudent options. As decisions are made, I will keep everyone informed. Please, keep us all in your prayers.

Queridos feligreses,

En septiembre de 2019, nuestra parroquia se fusionó oficialmente como una parroquia con dos lugares de culto. Uno de los mayores desafíos ha sido la administración de siete edificios antiguos. Por eso te escribo hoy.

En agosto, la Oficina Diocesana de Edificios y Terrenos hizo una evaluación de las propiedades en Transfiguration. Llevamos mucho tiempo teniendo problemas con el tejado. A lo largo de los años, se hicieron muchos trabajos de retazos, pero su eficacia se ha desgastado. Se descubrieron otros problemas de mantenimiento. La conclusión es que el costo para hacer que la Iglesia de la Transfiguración sea segura y estable se estima en \$800,000. Esto no incluiría nuevos sistemas de calefacción y aire acondicionado. Además, la rectoría necesitaría aproximadamente \$500,000 en reparaciones para ser elegible para alquiler.

Actualmente hay tres iglesias a muy poca distancia a pie (Transfiguración, San Estanislao y Santa Cruz). La población católica ya no los llena como antes. Entonces, tenemos un problema. La falta de necesidad de tres lugares de culto hace difícil justificar el coste de las reparaciones de la Transfiguración; un costo que no podríamos cubrir como parroquia pero que tendríamos que incurrir como otra deuda diocesana.

Presenté esta situación a la Junta Asesora Financiera Parroquial (Kevin Cavanagh, Dennis Gander, Mike LoCascio y Bill Valley). Aunque nadie estaba a favor del cierre de Transfiguración, nadie tenía alternativas que recomendar. La misma información se presentó en una reunión conjunta de la Junta Financiera y el Consejo Parroquial (asistieron los miembros de la Junta de Finanzas y María Flaim, Sandra Martínez, Marge Migliaccio y Nick Sacco. Karin Gully asistió como secretaria) y se llegó a la misma conclusión. Aunque entristeció a todos, me aconsejaron informar al Vicario General de la Diócesis, Mons. Joseph Grimaldi, que no vemos ninguna opción al cierre de la Iglesia de la Transfiguración y la venta de la propiedad.

Presentará esos hallazgos al obispo Brennan para que tome una decisión. Aún no hay nada definitivo, pero es muy probable que el obispo coincida en que no hay opciones prudentes. A medida que se tomen decisiones, mantendré a todos informados. Por favor, manténganos a todos en sus oraciones.
