



National Shrine of The Divine Mercy Stockbridge, MA

The grounds of the National Shrine consists of 375 acres of land nestled in the beautiful Berkshire hills in western Massachusetts. The name of the property is called "Eden Hill" because of its natural beauty.

On the grounds of Eden Hill, please explore the Na-Shrine chapel itself (The "Shrine tional Church,") which offers daily Mass, Confessions, Adoration, Rosary, benediction, the Chaplet of Divine Mercy, the blessing of religious articles, and a blessing with a first-class relic of St. Faustina.
