

## THE TWENTY SECOND SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

As a kid, I remembered the first weekend in September as a warning that school was opening and for the Jerry Lewis Telethon. Both of those are true, but the weekend is celebrated more as Labor Day weekend.

Labor Day began to be celebrated at the end of the 19th Century as a way to honor the contributions of workers to American society, to acknowledge the benefits of work not only to the individual but also to the community. Not too long ago a friend of mine lamented that he hated his job. I simply reminded him that there were many unemployed who wish they had a job to hate. As we celebrate this coming Labor Day, let us remember in prayer those who yearn for honest work.
