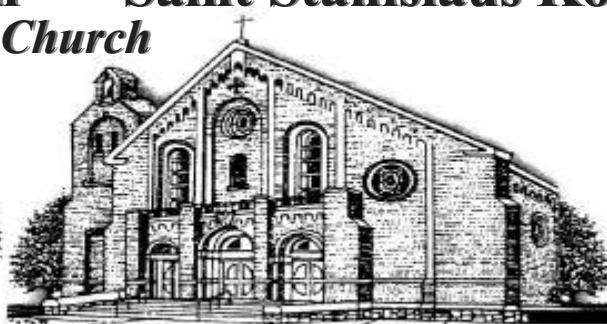
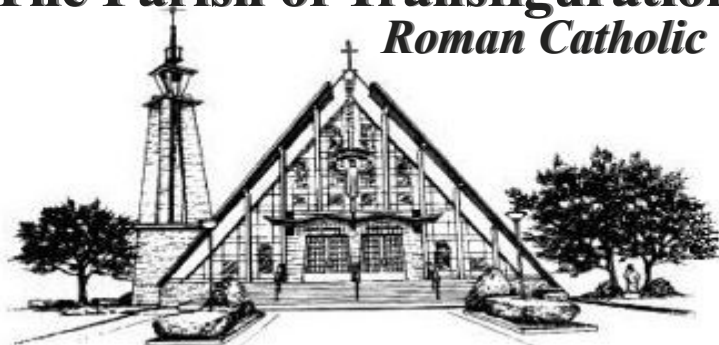

Sometime before Easter send a note, card, or phone call to reveal your identity to your Secret Prayer Partner!

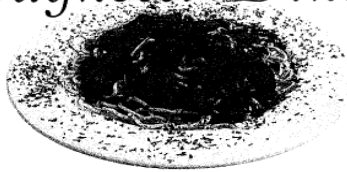

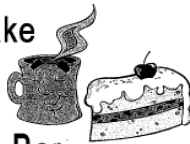
