Pope Francis has approved a new three-stage process for the next gathering of the Synod of Bishops; this process continues his efforts to reform the Catholic Church in accordance with the teachings of the Second Vati-For a synodal Church can Council. His aim is to involve the whole church at diocesan, national and continental levels through a pro-

cess of "listening and discernment" on the important theme of synodality: "For a synodal Church: communion, participation, and mission."

Pope Francis declared that the synod will open in the Vatican and in every diocese throughout the Catholic world The purpose of the diocesan phase is "to consult the people of God, so that the synodal process may be carried out by listening to all the bap-tized," who, as the Second Vatican Council said, "cannot err in matters of belief."


