LITURGY OF THE WORD Every Mass begins and ends with the sign of the cross. It is the most prominent sign of our identity as Christians. Saint Paul boasts in it, for it has transformed us all. The disciples bear it, sent out as lambs among wolves. The cross is our reminder that we should expect to suffer. But it is also a reminder of our redemption. Isaiah sings of the return to Jerusalem from exile, a redemption for Israel. Let us note the power of the cross as we listen to today's readings.


