

As I began to put together some thoughts for this weekend's bulletin, my mind immediately went to Father's Day. Then it went blank. For some reason, it was much easier to write about Mother's Day. I turned to the internet for some inspiration and found fifteen different articles that described how well Father's Day complemented Mother's Day. After much searching, I finally came across a website (morning glow.com) that offered some interesting information. So, in honor of all the dads, and all the other role models we men have encountered in our lives, I offer this simple explanation of how this day came to be:

### Happy Father's Day

Any man can be a Father, but it takes a special person to be called Dad.

The idea for creating a day for children to honor their fathers began in Spokane, Washington. A woman by the name of Sonora Smart Dodd thought of the idea for Father's Day while listening to a Mother's Day sermon in 1909.

Having been raised by her father, William Jackson Smart, after her mother died, Sonora wanted her father to know how special he was to her. It was her father that made all the parental sacrifices and was, in the eyes of his daughter, a courageous, selfless, and loving man. Sonora's father was born in June, so she chose to hold the first Father's Day celebration in Spokane, Washington on the 19th of June, 1910.

In 1926, a National Father's Day Committee was formed in New York City. Father's Day was recognized by a Joint Resolution of Congress in 1956. In 1972, President Richard Nixon established a permanent national observance of Father's Day to be held on the third Sunday of June. So Father's Day was born in memory and gratitude by a daughter who thought that her father and all good fathers should be honored with a special day just like we honor our mothers on Mother's Day.

There are three basic reasons why the church is not open on Sundays:

<u>First</u> - Sunday is the day we livestream Mass; we can't celebrate the Mass if the church is open to the public and the Diocese has not yet authorized churches to be open for public Mass.

**Second** - our limited volunteer chaperones are already serving two, three and even four days a week. **Third**, and finally, it is a day when we cannot be sure that there will not be too many people in the church at one time.

It is sad that we have to think this way now.

Let's continue to pray for a swift end to the pandemic so the restrictions can be lifted and we can once again feel comfortable, safe and welcome in God's house.


