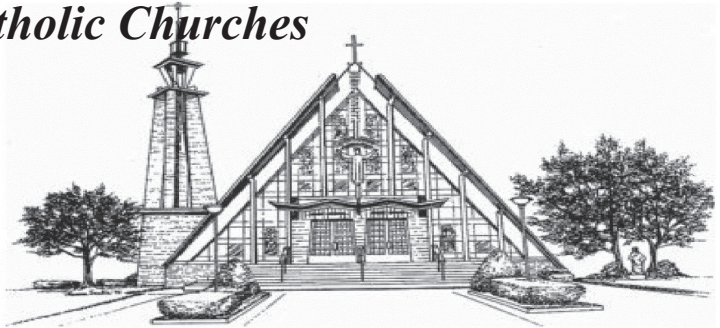
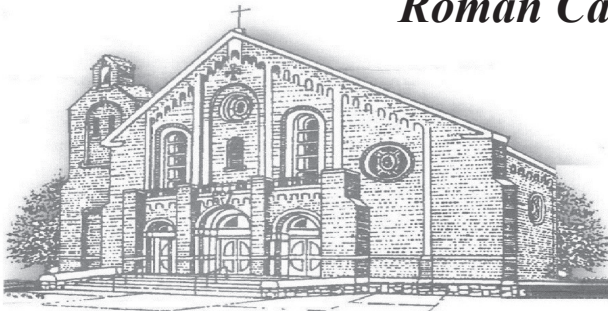

**Eucharistic Ministers:**

Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion assist in distributing Holy Communion at Sunday Masses, at special celebrations & to the home-bound. Eucharistic ministers must have received the Sacrament of Confirmation and be actively practicing their faith.

**Ushers/Greeters:**

Ushering is one of the most important Sunday morning volunteer activities. Couples and friends can sign up to serve together. This is the perfect opportunity for new members, for it offers the chance to say hello to everyone and for everyone to say hello to you! Ushers perform essential ministry of welcoming all to Mass and assisting in various duties before, during, and after mass including help seat parishioners, distribute bulletins and assist with the collection of gifts.

**Altar Servers:**

Altar Servers perform a very important and much needed role in liturgical services. This role includes assisting the Priest Celebrant at Mass and other liturgies of the church, including weddings and funerals. The activities of the altar server include carrying lighted candles, holding books, vessels and other liturgical items, assisting during Baptisms, etc. The humble service of the altar server helps to eliminate distractions and enables other ministers to simplify their motions during liturgical services.
