Next Saturday the Second Graders of our Parish will be receiving the First Holy Communion. It is always a joy and privilege to offer the Body and Blood of Christ but there is something special about witnessing the enthusiasm and faith of the children as they experience this intimacy with Jesus for the first time. Congratulations to all of them - we certainly hope that this is only the first of many. This also gives those of us who received our First Communion years ago to remember how special a moment each reception of Communion is.

This is a good opportunity to remind everyone that during the ongoing pandemic, the bishops have asked that out of consideration for one another everyone receive Communion in their hand. Those who do not wish to comply with this simple request from the bishops, are instructed to wait until all the others have received before approaching the altar. The Priests and Eucharistic Ministers are instructed by the Bishops that if they distribute Communion to anyone on his/her tongue, the Minister must sanitize his/her hands before distributing to anyone else. This is a temporary request because of the unusual nature of the times. Cooperation is appreciated.

Los obispos instruyen a los sacerdotes y ministros eucarísticos que si distribuyen la Comunión a alguien en su lengua, el ministro debe desinfectarse las manos antes de distribuirla a cualquier otra persona. Esta es una solicitud temporal debido a la naturaleza inusual de los tiempos. Se agradece la cooperación.


