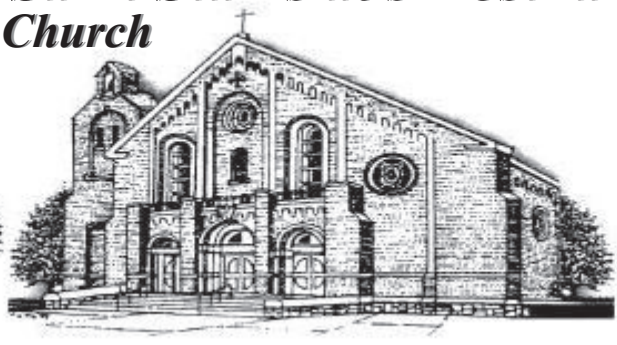

THIRD SUNDAY OF LENT



This week, we celebrate two of the most popular Patron Saints in New York City: **Saint Patrick** (March 17), Patron of the Archdiocese of New York and **Saint Joseph** (March 19), Patron of the Universal Church.

The teachings of St. Patrick can best be seen in his famous prayer, "The Breastplate". It reads, "Christ shield me this day: Christ with me, Christ before me, Christ behind me, Christ in me, Christ beneath me, Christ above me, Christ on my right, Christ on my left, Christ when I lie down, Christ when I arise, Christ in the heart of every person who thinks of me, Christ in the eye that sees me, Christ in the ear that hears me".

It was about St. Joseph that Saint Bernadine of Siena wrote, "He was chosen by the eternal Father as the trustworthy guardian and protector of his greatest treasures, namely, his divine Son and Mary, Joseph's wife. He carried out this vocation with complete fidelity until at last God called him, saying: 'Good and faithful servant, enter into the joy of your Lord'."

We pray that these two great saints will inspire each of us to seek lives of holiness.

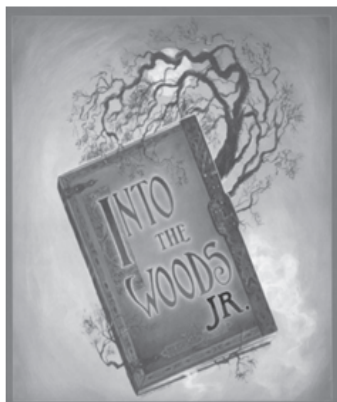
