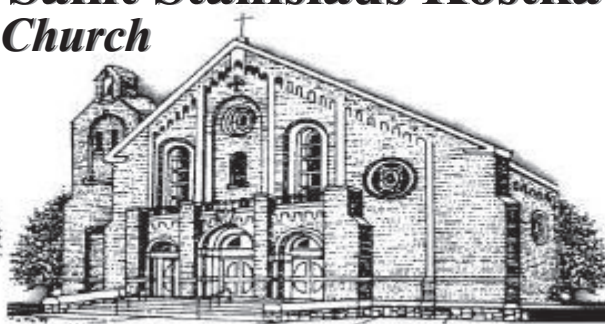

Be with those who lead and give them Your spirit of wisdom.

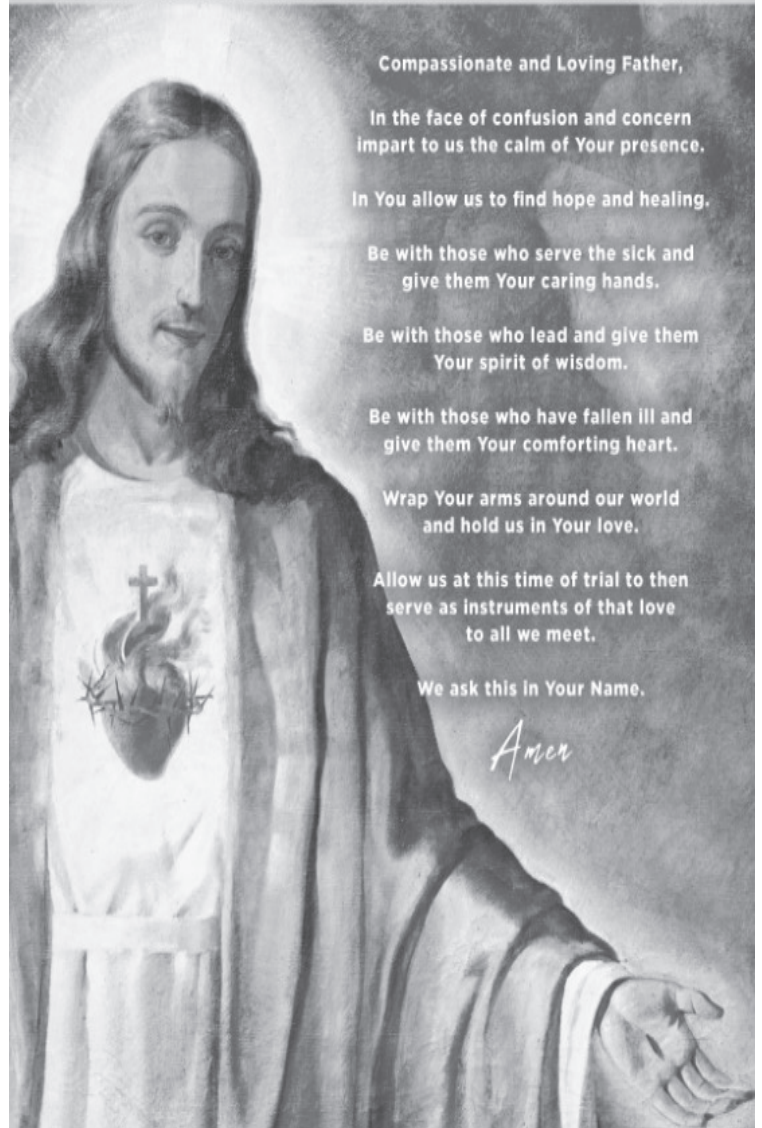
Be with those who have fallen ill and give them Your comforting heart.
