


The “**Traditional Latin Mass**,” more correctly the Extraordinary Form of the Roman Rite (the Ordinary Form is the Mass we are all familiar with), is the liturgy used in our parish and in most Catholic churches prior to 1969. It is very ancient: if Pope St Gregory the Great (who died in A.D. 604) walked into a church today and saw it being celebrated, he would be able to follow it easily, for it was already ancient in his day. It has so deeply marked Western culture — literature, architecture, painting, sculpture, and glorious music — that in 1970 over one hundred public figures, from artists to authors to musicians, even the mystery writer Agatha Christie, wrote to Paul VI pleading that it not be completely lost as his new liturgy took hold of the Church. And so it is preserved, retaining its hold on many devout Catholics, and is surprisingly popular among young people today.

The Traditional Latin Mass is being celebrated on the 1st, 2nd, 3rd Sunday of each month in Transfiguration Church at 11am. Please note that the **LAST Sunday of each month is still the Lithuanian Mass at 11:30am; also on December 8th the Latin Mass will be at 10:45am.**

PLEASE, be patient. As you know, we have begun celebrating the Traditional Mass at Transfiguration. As we announced in September, the plan is that in January that Mass will be celebrated at the 12:30 time slot at Transfiguration. Until then it is being celebrated at 11. Because of this, there are two Masses at 11 and two Masses at 12:30 on our Sunday schedule. Since Fr Vytas also celebrates Mass at Annunciation in Brooklyn his availability is limited. Consequently, the schedule does not allow for each priest to celebrate each Mass at least once a month. This is a temporary problem. Once the schedule solidifies in January, a regular rotation will again occur.


