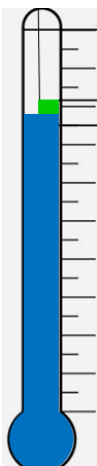

CARDINAL ANNOUNCEMENT!!!!



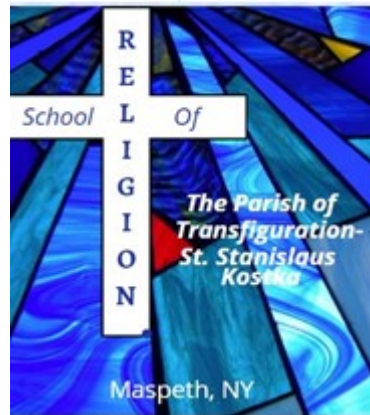
Dear Parent/Guardians, and Parishioners,
