





October 4th/St Francis of Assisi Day and the Blessing of Animals

One of the most beloved saints of all time is Francis of Assisi, the Poverello, or little Poor Man. Born the son of a well-to-do merchant, as a young man he experienced a powerful conversion, and embarked upon a life of humility and poverty in imitation of Jesus. His example inspired many to follow him, and the Franciscan Order was formed, and spear-headed a powerful thirteenth century renewal of the whole Church.

His love of nature and of animals, in which he saw images of the goodness of God, is legendary, and in memory of his holy life we bless animals each year on his feast day.

This year, on Monday October 4th at 4PM, bring your pets to the school yard for a blessing. Cats, dogs, birds, rabbits, ferrets, iguanas... whatever little or not so little companion whose friendship reminds you of the goodness of God, bring them to the Blessing of Animals!
