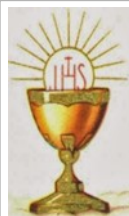

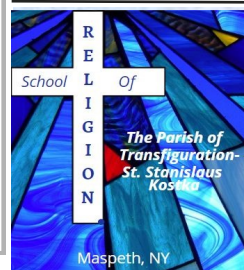

COVID-19 REMINDERS

An Important Update Regarding the Use of Parish and Diocesan Facilities

Due to the rise in infection rates, there are to be no large gatherings in parish buildings, including school auditoriums, gyms and cafeterias. This includes:

- All indoor sporting events (including CYO)
- Parish receptions of any kind
- Large Parish meetings

The prohibition does not include Religious Education Classes, the safety protocols for which have been previously issued.

A smaller gathering can be held with the necessary safety protocols in place if it is possible to create enough social distancing. This capacity is based on the total number the space can accommodate with allowance for social distancing. Masks are required and there must be no shared objects (utensils, etc.).

For celebrations of the liturgy in church, please note that the same protocols remain in place, that is, masks are highly encouraged (even for those who are vaccinated), social distancing (especially for the unvaccinated) to the extent possible is to be practiced and there should be no physical contact.

Communion in the hand is the preferred and encouraged method for the reception of Holy Communion by the Faithful.

It is very important that these safety measures be adhered to as the infection rates continue to rise.

These guidelines and protocols are to remain in effect until the end of this year. Please know that we will be carefully monitoring the situation. Further changes may be necessary.

El obispo DiMarzio ha pedido que se comunique lo siguiente sobre

RECORDATORIOS COVID-19

Una actualización importante sobre el uso de las instalaciones parroquiales y diocesanas

Debido al aumento de las tasas de infección, no habrá grandes reuniones en los edificios parroquiales, incluidos los auditorios escolares, los gimnasios y las cafeterías. Esto incluye:

- Todos los eventos deportivos de interior (incluido CYO)
- Recepciones parroquiales de cualquier tipo
- Grandes reuniones parroquiales

La prohibición no incluye las Clases de Educación Religiosa, cuyos protocolos de seguridad se han emitido previamente.

Se puede realizar una reunión más pequeña con los protocolos de seguridad necesarios implementados si es posible crear suficiente distanciamiento social. Esta capacidad se basa en el número total que el espacio puede acomodar con un margen para el distanciamiento social. Se requieren máscaras y no debe haber objetos compartidos (utensilios, etc.).

Para las celebraciones de la liturgia en la iglesia, tenga en cuenta que se mantienen los mismos protocolos, es decir, se recomienda encarecidamente el uso de máscaras (incluso para aquellos que están vacunados), se debe practicar el distanciamiento social (especialmente para los no vacunados) en la medida de lo posible, y no debe haber contacto físico.

La Comunión en la mano es el método preferido y alentado para la recepción de la Sagrada Comunión por los Fieles.

Es muy importante que se cumplan estas medidas de seguridad ya que las tasas de infección continúan aumentando.

Estas pautas y protocolos permanecerán en vigor hasta finales de este año. Tenga en cuenta que estaremos monitoreando cuidadosamente la situación. Pueden ser necesarios más cambios.

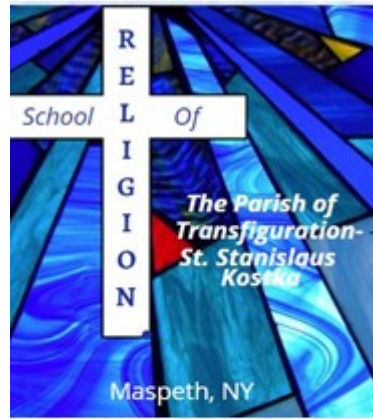
