




LITURGY OF THE WORD

Today's lessons are not easy. Wisdom acknowledges that God's ways cannot be understood through human thought. Jesus, explaining what it takes to follow him, repeatedly frames the requirements as "whoever does not . . . cannot be my disciple." But Paul is encouraging and positive, speaking of the conversion of someone who was once a slave, but is now a brother and partner. As we listen today, let us find hope in our mission as Christ's twenty-first-century disciples.

El Dr. Allen Hunt nació en una familia metodista con una larga línea de pastores. A pesar de no tener la intención de entrar en "el negocio familiar", el Dr. Hunt terminó siendo un ministro metodista.

Mientras dirigía una megaglesia evangélica (sirviendo a más de 15,000 personas cada semana), Allen R. Hunt comenzó un viaje notable que culminó en su conversión al catolicismo. Ahora se desempeña como asesor principal en Dynamic Catholic y es un comunicador católico conocido a nivel nacional, maestro bíblico y autor de mayor venta, y hasta 2013, fue el anfitrión de "The Allen Hunt Show", un programa de radio sindicado que se centró en cuestiones de fe y moralidad.

Allen y su esposa, Anita, tienen dos hijas casadas y cuatro nietos. La parroquia de Allen está en McDonough, Georgia.

Dr. Allen Hunt was born into a Methodist family with a long line of pastors. Despite not intending to go into "the family business", Dr. Hunt did in fact end up becoming a Methodist minister.

While leading an evangelical mega-church (serving more than 15,000 people each week), Allen R. Hunt began a remarkable journey that culminated in his conversion to Catholicism. He now serves as the senior advisor at Dynamic Catholic and is a nationally known Catholic communicator, Bible teacher, and best-selling author, and until 2013, was the host of "The Allen Hunt Show", a syndicated radio talk show that focused on issues of faith and morality.

Allen and his wife, Anita, have two grown married daughters and four grandsons. Allen's home parish is in McDonough, Georgia.
